#2 – Eliminate Risks of Windows XP End of Support

Risks

- Lack of support from ISVs and OEMs for the new applications and PC hardware
- Security and compliance issues running unsupported software
- Need to purchase expensive custom support
- Office 2013 does not work with Windows XP




