

# Adobe Term Site License

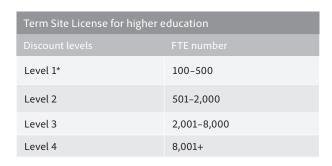
The low-cost, low-maintenance way to deploy Adobe software across educational institutions

The Adobe Term Site License (TSL) program offers higher education Cumulative Licensing Program (CLP) members worldwide a low-cost option for deploying Adobe software throughout their entire site. Instead of purchasing and managing software licenses for various products across staff members, your higher education institution can license a select set of Adobe Education products for its whole site for a specific period of time, so faculty and staff can install and use the applications they need when they need them without tracking and managing individual licenses.

## How it works

If your qualified higher education institution is already an Adobe CLP education member, you are eligible to participate in the TSL program. You can set up a site license for the eligible Adobe Education software you need for a specific term, which is with your CLP membership. The duration of your TSL term can vary from 6 to 24 months depending on the remaining time on your CLP membership. For more details and to enroll in the TSL program, contact your Adobe education reseller. You can also conveniently enroll online. Pricing and the number of licenses authorized for use is determined by the term of the site license and the total number of full-time-equivalent (FTE) faculty and staff at your qualified site. The table below shows the standard discount levels based on the total FTE at the qualified site. You can also purchase additional licenses during your TSL term with pricing prorated to the end of your CLP membership. In addition, partial site coverage may also be available for qualifying sites.

An eligible site is an accredited higher education institution, such as a public or private college or university. Museums, printing services, for-profit training centers, and student computer labs are not eligible to be part of a term site license, even if they are owned by the CLP education member. Product availability for the TSL program varies by region. For details, contact your local Adobe Education reseller.

# Advantages of TSL

Term site licensing enables educational institutions to spread the cost of Adobe software ownership over the TSL period, which stabilizes your software budget predictability while offering flexible software deployment across your entire organization. You no longer need to individually track and manage software usage for every user in your organization. Upgrade Plan is automatically included for all products licensed through the TSL program. Your site will automatically receive product updates and upgrades as soon as they are available, helping to ensure that your faculty and staff will always be using the latest versions of Adobe software.

Your TSL runs concurrently with your CLP membership, so you don't need to track them separately, and you can renew both agreements at the same time. In addition, your TSL accrues points that are added to your CLP membership, so you can maximize your overall discount level. When you enroll in the TSL program, you will receive a certificate that includes a list of your licensed products, the number of available licenses, the duration of your TSL term, and serial numbers for each product, so you can easily manage your Adobe software licenses.

## Program benefits at a glance

- Get coverage of selected Adobe Education software products within a given timeframe for an entire site; no need to account for each faculty member's Adobe software usage.
- Contribute to your overall CLP for education point total with TSL purchases.
- Receive updates and upgrades to the covered software during the term of the agreement.
