

### Print faster from powersave with HP.

Our Instant-on fusers radically reduce warm-up time and let HP users print many documents before the Xerox unit can finish warming up.




### Scan and digital send documents faster with HP.

### Enjoy reliable print quality with HP.

HP's innovative integrated LaserJet print cartridges contain the toner, drum, developer, and charge roller, yielding consistently great print quality since you refresh the LaserJet M4345's imaging system every 18,000 pages when you replace its toner. Xerox WorkCentre 4150 toner cartridges don't include the drum, which only gets replaced every 55,000 pages and can lead to excessive background gray, vertical streaking, and poor toner adhesion on output. This approach also doubles the number of consumables Xerox users must order, store, and replace.



## Get a more robust imaging system with HP.

Xerox WorkCentre 4150 users must be very careful when removing the toner cartridge or clearing paper jams since doing so exposes the photoconductive imaging drum, which can be irreparably damaged by sunlight, fingerprints, or any nicks or scratches and costs \$279 to replace.<sup>4</sup> HP users can relax, because their device's imaging drum is fully protected within HP's innovative integrated LaserJet print cartridge.
