


HP LaserJet 4250 vs. Dell W5300n



Faster warm-up from Powersave



Significant differences between these printers could impact...

user productivity:

Less wait time – The HP LaserJet 4250 warms up and prints from Powersave in 8.4 seconds, compared to 43.7 seconds for the Dell W5300n. This allows the HP LaserJet 4250 to print 27 pages before the Dell W5300n prints one from Powersave.

Reliable print quality – HP offers completely integrated toner cartridges, which yield consistently good print quality over time, while the Dell toner cartridges do not include a charge roller, which may require separate replacement to maintain acceptable print quality.

total cost of ownership:

Simplified paper trays – Be sure to compare paper tray designs. HP's paper trays are designed to be easy to load, easy to adjust for various paper sizes and durable.

Manage multiple printers at once – HP's WebJetadmin enables streamlined management of multiple printers at once, while Dell provides no solution for managing multiple printers.
