THE CHALLENGE

Zones is the IT solutions and services provider for a leading freight forwarder and logistics provider with more than 3,700 employees in 240 offices worldwide, in more than 80 countries. The company specializes in customerfocused air, ocean, customs brokerage, warehousing, import and export, and supply chain management.

Over the last few years, the freight company has experienced rapid growth driven by the acquisition of several companies. These acquisitions led to Microsoft initiating software audits two years in a row to ensure licensing compliance. As a result, the company paid substantial and unexpected true-up costs of \$1.3 million and \$1.2 million for the years the audits took place.

THE SOLUTION
